Construction Project Update:

Foundations are being poured for the speaker poles at the football stadium. The goal is to have the speakers ready for use at the May 18th Alpha Wolf assembly. Eighty five percent (85%) of the boiler work has been completed. Planning for both the Junior High hallway and Intermediate roof work is complete. These renovations will occur this summer along with the secure entrances at Huntington Woods ECC.

Bond Planning Update:
