WHS Alpha Wolf Champions of Character Presentation:

Josh Baumbach, Wyoming High School principal, and John Doyle, Wyoming High School teacher, introduced the guests to the Board and provided an overview of their three presentations.

WHS junior students Lily McKenney and Sofia Barajas-Gutierrez opened the presentations by reflecting on the Alpha Wolf 11 (AW11) Leadership Retreat held at Camp Manitou-Lin. They shared personal insights from their experience and highlighted the impact of the retreat on the 122 students who participated. Their reflections emphasized the development of leadership skills, character, and meaningful connections fostered through the retreat experience.

WHS students Sofia Barajas-Gutierrez and Tina Vo followed with an overview of the Wyoming High School Alpha Wolf 11 Champion of Character Program presentation being prepared for the upcoming Super Regional Connect Conference on Thursday, January 22nd. They noted the collaborative efforts of the AW11 Student Leadership Team, National Honor Society, and Student Council in developing the presentation and representing Wyoming High School.

Mr. Doyle then introduced the eight new first semester Alpha Wolf 11 Champions of Character award recipients (Asa Bartholomew, Nicole Jimenez, Nerissa Cruz, Xenya Zambrana, Chalom Ganza, Lyric McPhee, Ava DeGennaro, Cesar Silva). These scholars were selected by staff and peers at Wyoming High School as Alpha Wolf 11 Champions of Character who exemplify the core values of kindness, compassion, and gratitude in all that they do. The award recipients provided insight on the Alpha Wolf 11 program, highlighting its impact on fostering positive character development within the school community.

Several recent AW11 Champion of Character award recipients were in attendance along with members of their family. They shared brief remarks on the significance of the recognition and its impact on them individually, the school community, and the broader Wyoming community. This recognition portion highlighted the continued emphasis on character, leadership, and positive contributions within Wyoming High School.
