June 10, 2026 Thrun Policy
Updates:
Action Item – Approved

The Board reviewed and approved the June 10, 2026, Thrun Board Policy updates, which are intended to ensure the District remains compliant with current laws and regulations. WHS Band Camp Show:	Wyoming Wolves Band Camp is currently underway, and students are preparing for the 2026 marching band season. This year's show, entitled "X Marks the Moment," features a pirate-themed performance. The annual Band Camp Show was held on Friday, August 7, at 6:30 PM at the high school stadium, and community members were encouraged to attend in support of the students and program.
Football & Cheer Teams Overnighter:	The Board was informed of the Wyoming Wolves Football & Cheer "Midnight Madness" Overnight event, which serves as the official kickoff to the 2026 football season. The event will begin with family time, including food trucks on campus and opportunities for student-athletes to engage with their families by demonstrating football drills and practice activities. Athletes and families will also be invited to attend a family movie before the evening transitions into structured overnight team activities. The football team will participate in a Midnight Madness practice under the lights beginning at 12:00 a.m., followed by rest and continued programming. Breakfast will be provided the next morning, with a Monday morning practice concluding the event. The group will make every effort to limit noise during overnight hours, and the overnight practice has been approved by the City of Wyoming.
WJH Credit Intervention Plan:	The Board was provided the Wyoming Junior High (WJH) Credit and Intervention Plan for review. The plan is designed to promote higher academic standards, provide earlier support for students, and ensure strong preparation for high school. Its purpose is to build consistent academic habits, address and close priority skill gaps, and establish a clear understanding of credit beginning in seventh grade, prior to students entering high school.
2026-2027 School Year Preparation:	The Board received an update on District preparations for the 2026–2027 school year, with the first day of school scheduled for Tuesday, August 25, 2026. Preparations include staffing and onboarding, professional development planning, curriculum alignment, facility readiness, and transportation coordination. The district is focused on ensuring a smooth and successful start to the school year for all students and staff.
Professional Learning Communities At Work Institute:	From August 10–12, a team of 60 WPS educators will gain valuable insights and practical tools to implement Professional Learning Communities (PLCs). The institute will focus on three foundational ideas: focusing on learning, building a collaborative culture, and maintaining a results orientation. Participants will have direct access

to national experts with hands-on PLC experience, as well as keynote speakers who will address shared leadership and school culture.

August 18, 19, and 20 teachers in their first three years will participate in specially designed professional development designed to support their professional growth. August 18 will focus on onboarding new employees, while August 19 and 20 will feature learning sessions facilitated by Lani Dykhouse, WPS Instructional Coach, and Katie Momber, KISD Educator Support Consultant. Their sessions will emphasize learning about student engagement, instructional practices, and classroom management.
