2. Describe the district's methodology and decision-making for distributing Section 31a At-risk grant funds to target the buildings with the highest needs.

Section 31a funds are utilized to support students who meet Section 31a eligibility and are identified as needing additional reading and math intervention based on criteria specified by the district.

3. What evidence-based interventions and services were implemented with the Section 31a At-risk grant funds during the 2025-26 grant cycle?

Each of the seven WPS schools provided research-based interventions to eligible and identified students based on the review of assessment data that outlined each student's specific skills in need of development and support. Interventions include, but are not limited to: Boost, Reflex Math, UFLI Foundations, and Read 180.

4. In what ways has the district collected feedback from parents or legal guardians on these interventions and services provided this year?

Parents/Guardians are made aware of interventions provided to eligible students by teachers. Progress is shared with parents and guardians through email, parent teacher conferences, and any necessary phone calls.

5. Describe the method parents or legal guardians may use to provide feedback on the use of these funds.

Parents/Guardians are notified of intervention supports available for their child by teachers each year. Throughout the intervention period parents are updated with skill progress.
