	<u>ASK</u>	Who What = Direct Object	<u>THEN ASK</u>	to/for who to/for what = Indirect Object if it is BEFORE the Direct Object	=	Objective Complement if it is AFTER the Direct Object
Subject &	Action Verb					

Sylvia sent Arnie a fuzzy scarf for his birthday.

Subject *Action Verb* *Indirect Object* *Direct Object*

She painted her room green.

Subject *Action Verb* *Direct Object* *Objective Complement*



Subject &	Linking Verb	Noun or Pronoun that describes the subject = Predicate Nominative	OR	Adjective that describes the subject = Predicate Adjective
-----------	---------------------	--	-----------	---

Hawkins remained the best player on the team.

Subject *Linking Verb* *Predicate Nominative*

The air from the ridge smelled smokey.

Subject *Linking Verb* *Predicate Adjective*
