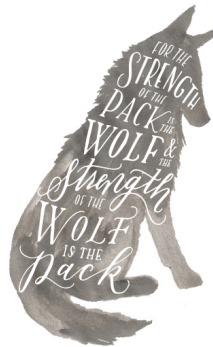
You may **SKIP** any question you do not wish to answer, and your responses will remain anonymous and confidential.
