6/29/20 Board Minutes: Action Item – Approved	The Board reviewed and approved the minutes of the regular session WPS Board of Education meeting held virtually at 5 PM on Monday, June 29, 2020.
Personnel Transactions: Action Item – Approved	The Board approved the following personnel transactions: <u>Retirements / Resignations:</u> Kazimir Matanovic, Head Custodian–Oriole Park, Effective July 31, 2020
Preparedness and Response Plan:	Members of the Board have received a draft of the District preparedness and response plan. This document is continuously being revised based upon Executive Orders received from the Governor’s office. This document is an active part of the planning process but a separate document than the safe school re-entry plan.
Safe School Start Advisory Group and Committee Update:	The Safe School Start Advisory Committee will soon be receiving recommendations from the five subcommittees 1) Parents 2) Safety & Health 3) Professional Learning 4) Social & Emotional 5) Instruction. The committees are working aggressively, and the Safe Start Re-Entry Plan will be submitted for the Board to review and take action on at the August 10th Board meeting. The District will be prepared to welcome students on August 25th whether that is in person or online. We will also be able to pivot based upon what Phase we are in and what is needed to best take care of our students and staff.
Online Registration:	Online enrollment and registration will launch this week through ParentVue. Families will be asked to declare which learning experience (in person or online) they select by no later than August 14th.
WHS Class of 2020 Commencement:	On Tuesday, July 28th at 7 PM WHS Class of 2020 graduates will be invited to participate in a drive up graduation ceremony at Wyoming High School.
Finance Reports – June 2020: Action Item – Approved	The Board reviewed and approved the June 2020 check register.
Change Order #009 - Abatement: Action Item – Approved	The Board reviewed and approved change order #009 in the amount of \$138,750 to add abatement costs to the demo contract per the bid submission by Protech Demolition.

<p>Final Cleaning: Action Item – Approved</p>	<p>The Board reviewed bids received for final cleaning. The lowest bid on the project was submitted by and awarded to Green Cleaning in the amount of \$46,310. The Christman Company invited lowest bidding firms to a formal post bid interview to vet out the candidates.</p>
<p>Summer School:</p>	<p>Our 6-week remote summer school program wrapped up last week. Our teaching staff & TEAM 21 staff did a terrific job providing summer learning experiences and extension activities over the past six weeks. We had the following attendance: elementary: 229 began & 208 completed the full six weeks; intermediate: 49 began & 47 completed the full six weeks, and WJH had 45 who began and 36 who completed the full six weeks.</p>
<p>Fall Instructional Planning Update:</p>	<p>The Instruction Subcommittee met Monday, July 20 to continue the planning of instructional re-entry plans for our K-12 students. Our goal is to present recommendations to the WPS Safe Schools Advisory Committee on July 29 as it relates to a fully online model (phases 1-3) and an in-person model (phases 4 & 5). The WPS Virtual option is currently being built by a team of 33 teachers. This is the option families will have in the event they do not feel safe sending their child(ren) back to school if we are in phase 4.</p>
<p>Summer School Update:</p>	<p>The PD Subcommittee met on Tuesday, July 21 to identify key areas of professional learning for staff, students, and our families. These areas include health & safety; curriculum & instruction; social-emotional; technology, and race & equity.</p>
<p>WHS Student Trip Request: Action Item – Approved</p>	<p>We are in our third week of our remote summer school program. We were able to hire an additional 2nd grade teacher as there was an increase in enrollment. Additionally, two social workers were hired to support our students participating in summer programming.</p>
<p>WHS Student Trip Request: Action Item – Approved</p>	<p>The Board reviewed and approved the WHS senior trip request to travel to Michigan Adventure. WHS 2020 Senior class members will receive an annual pass to Michigan Adventure for the 2020 and 2021 park seasons. This pass is in lieu of the missed Senior All Night Party.</p>
<p>Reinstatement of Student 1920.02: Action Item - Approved</p>	<p>The Board reviewed and approved a request to allow student 1920.02 to return to Wyoming Public Schools per a specific plan of expectation.</p>
