Building Spotlight Presentation – Wyoming High School:

WHS Principal Josh Baumbach, teacher John Doyle and scholars currently enrolled in the Educators Rising course at Wyoming High School were in attendance on Monday (02/28/22) evening to share the Wyoming High School building spotlight presentation.

The group provided a [PowerPoint presentation](#) overview of the course, a listing of activities they have participated in, and why they think the course is “worth it.” The scholars defined their class purpose which was: *To empower diverse students to engage in a guided exploration of being a future educator with hands-on teaching experiences, understanding the profession, and developing the skills and first steps on the path to accomplished teaching.
