Thrun Board Policy Updates: **Action Item – Approved**

The Board was provided an overview of eleven (11) Thrun Board Policies (4108, 4207, 4402, 4403, 4404, 4405, 4407, 4408, 4409, 4503, 4504) requiring updates to bring them into compliance with new legislative changes to the Michigan Public Employment Relations Act (PERA), the State School Aid Act (SSAA), the Revised School Code (RSC), and the Teachers' Tenure Act (TTA). WIS Bid Awards: Action Item – Approved The Board reviewed and approved a bid award recommendation letter from the district's construction management firm, The Christman Company. The total cost of bids for over twenty work categories, plus contingencies and soft costs comes to \$7,539,209. This compares favorably to the nearly \$10 million that was projected and indicates some normalization in construction pricing following COVID-era spikes in many categories.
