The Board reviewed and approved a quote and proposal associated with entering into a three-year agreement with Transfinder, a transportation routing software system.

The Board reviewed and approved the Parkview Elementary scholar trip request for travel to and from Charlton Park in Hastings, Michigan on May 12, 2025. This educational experience will provide students with a hands-on opportunity to explore life in Michigan during the 19th century. Through interactive exhibits and historical demonstrations, students will gain a deeper understanding of daily life, trades, and customs from this era.

This trip aligns with Michigan state social studies standards and directly supports our new CKLA Knowledge Units, including topics such as the War of 1812 and the Civil War. By engaging with historical reenactments and immersive activities, students will build connections between classroom learning and real-world historical contexts. This experience will enhance comprehension of early American history while fostering curiosity and engagement with the past.

The Board reviewed and approved the Wyoming High School scholar trip request for travel to and from Orlando, Florida from May 7th through May 11th to compete in the Business Professionals of America (BPA) National Leadership Conference. scholars earned this prestigious opportunity by placing 2nd in the state competition, demonstrating exceptional skill, dedication, and professionalism in their respective events.

The BPA National Leadership Conference (NLC) is the premier event for student leaders in business, finance, technology, and marketing. This year's theme, Capture the Moment, encourages students to embrace new opportunities, celebrate their achievements, and create lasting memories as they compete, learn, and network with industry professionals. The conference will feature competitive events, leadership development workshops, and career-building experiences, including Universal's Business Learning Youth Program in partnership with CNBC. Attending the NLC will allow our students to showcase their talents on a national stage, connect with peers and professionals from across the country, and gain invaluable real-world experience in their fields of study.

As part of this partnership, Graduation Alliance is responsible for monitoring each student's progress and ensuring they achieve Satisfactory Monthly Progress as outlined in their individualized learning plans, in accordance with Section 23a of the State Aid Act.

While Satisfactory Progress is defined in the Graduation Alliance Policy and Operations Manual, our pupil accounting auditor has requested that this provision be approved as a standalone document. The document, titled "Satisfactory Academic Progress for MI 23a Program," outlines the specific criteria and expectations for scholars in the program.
